Thank you for another incredible year of providing therapeutic boat outings for all our participants, those with special needs and veterans. With just 3 full time and 2 part time employees most of this year, and with the help over 400 volunteers, by December 31, we will provide over 4500 on the water experiences. That's close to 1000 more than last year!

Imagine a parent with tears in their eyes saying,

"Thank you for this boat outing. We didn't think we could ever go boating with our child and you made it possible. I haven't seen him smile in over two years until today."

Think about a veteran with PTSD and a TBI, hiding out at home, only venturing out to grocery shop, in the middle of the night to avoid any potential conflict or trigger. That veteran is invited to come boating with Freedom Waters Foundation and finds a safe place for camaraderie; a loving, caring community; and goes home renewed and ready to venture into a new way of being.

For 17 years, Freedom Waters Foundation has been dedicated to our mission of Enhancing the lives of children, individuals with special needs and veterans by providing therapeutic boat experiences.


